Executive Board Meeting
December 04, 2024

Attendees: Co-Presidents: Dave Trimmer & Jan McCreary; Co-Vice Presidents: Ken Copeland & Dean Hultman; Treasurer: Diana Lyons and Secretary: Jennie Clement.

Meeting Called to Order: The meeting was held at Jennie's home and was called to Order by Dave Trimmer at 12:46 pm.

Reading of the Last Meeting Minutes: Jennie sent the Minutes of the 11/01/24 meeting to the Board on 12/03/24 to be reviewed prior to this meeting. A motion to accept the Minutes was made by Dave, seconded by Ken, passed unanimously.

Treasurers Report: Diana gave the Treasurer's report. Our current balance is \$5896.06. There are 178 paid members as of today. See Treasurer's report. A motion to accept the Treasurer's Report was made by Dave, seconded by Jan, passed unanimously.

Old News:

1. Shelves for the Tennis Shed:

- a. Do we need another one? The two shelves we currently have are enough.
- b. Are the shelves the right height for our needs? Dean may readjust a few. He and Jennie will work on this in the near future.
- c. Can Softball get someone to pick up their equipment? Jennie will talk to Kevin Wike about room.

2. How is the Schedule Working?:

- a. The Novice group would like to have more courts during their time as other players use the courts too. This is easily being adjusted by asking the non-novice players to use the Open Court. Novice Round Robins will be starting at the tennis court on this Thursday morning, Dec. 5.

b. The posted schedule is difficult to read as the hourly times are in the center of the block instead of on the left side. Jennie has revised that on the master spreadsheet and sent the revised schedule to Diana to post on the website.

3. **Is Court 1 Being Used?:** Court 1 is being used correctly by current players.

New News:

1. **Round Robins:** Round Robin coordinators will make a post regarding the type of play for Round Robins. It will include guidelines, rally scoring, etc. that will apply to all Round Robins. They will send the Board their list.
2. **New Committee:** The Competition and Development Committee members are Jimmy Myers, Don Olyear, and Mark Ford. Jan will organize a Women's Only Intermediate Clinic for Monday Dec. 16th. There will be rotating stations, not a Round Robin. The Committee won't run these clinics, just organize them or come up with ideas for different types of clinics.
3. **Tournament Chairman:** Linda Chadwell will be completing her two-year commitment as the Tournament Chairman. Therefore, we need to find another member who will take this on. Diana will ask Joe Carter if he would be willing to set up a survey to see if tournaments are still of interest to our members. Diana will do it if he cannot.
4. **Beginner Lessons:** Beginner training is covered for the rest of December by Board members and other previous trainers. Starting in January, the need for more trainers to be available may be necessary. At this point, we will wait and see. The trainer positions can be filled fairly quickly.
5. **Appointment of Website Manager:** Darryl Chadwell has agreed to take over as the Website Manger and he will also take over the tournament sign-ups. This is helpful for Linda this year. He will work with Diana to learn the system and she will also be his back-up when necessary. A motion to

accept the appointment of the Website Manager – Darryl Chadwell - was made by Dave, seconded by Jan, passed unanimously.

6. **GC Management Meeting Tomorrow:** Dave, Jan and Jennie will meet with Gini and Tracee on Thursday, Dec. 5th. We will push for what they promised us in the Spring. We will ask them how we can help convince Corporate of the needs to make/keep this a 5 star park. We deserve to know if we are getting the 4 courts or not so we can notify our members.
7. **Next Meeting:** Our next meeting is scheduled for January 8, 2025 at 1:00pm at Dave's house – 721 Pennsylvania.

Meeting Adjourned: A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Ken, seconded by Diana, passed unanimously. Meeting was adjourned at 2:08 pm.
