January 8, 2026

Meeting Called to Order: The meeting was called to order by Dean at 11:58AM MST.

Reading of the Last Meeting Minutes: The December Meeting Minutes were sent out prior to the meeting for review. Approval of the December Minutes was discussed. Ann Mary made a motion to accept the Minutes; seconded by Dean; it passed unanimously.

Treasurers Report: Greg: See reports. 175-180 paid members – lower than expected. On Budget at this time. Greg is working with his company to show finances over the 8 months we are active. Ken made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report; seconded by Don; it passed unanimously.

Old News:

- 1. New Ball Machine Status:** The new ball machine was ordered at the meeting. Discussion about the number of balls still available. We will need to order another box. Ken will discuss with Gini as to whether the Resort will pay for at least one box of balls and get back to us. Jennie will order a new box of balls.
- 2. Membership Dues vs Social Cost: Jennie:** Greg figured out that an increase of \$10.00 to our annual Membership Fee would equal out the charge of our Socials. There would be no charge for any of our Socials in the future. This would increase our Membership Fee to \$25.00/per member/year. Non-Members will still pay the \$5.00 for the Socials. Greg made a motion to raise the 2026-2027 Membership fee to \$25.00/member/year and that Non-Members will still pay the \$5.00 for the Socials, Ken seconded it, and it

passed unanimously. This will be mentioned at the next Social for information to the membership.

New News:

- 1. Website Access: Lori/Jennie:** There are several volunteers who have had access to writing blogs on the website in the past because of their roles in the Club. This has gotten a bit cluttered; therefore, using Daryl Chadwell's website guidelines from our 2024-2025 AGM, we are limiting the number of users to the website. (See below.) Only Board Members will have access to the website to make any changes. Notification will be sent out to the Membership that when anyone wants to post something to the website, they will send a request to the webmaster (currently Lori Irvine) for review, approval based on the policy and posting.
- 2. Membership List Validation: Jennie/Greg:** Discussion after the meeting. We will both continue to work on cleaning up the Membership website database.
- 3. Report on Round Robins: Dean/Ken:** Advanced Round Robins going well. A data dump will be shared to the Competition and Development Committee meeting today. There may be some movement between the levels. We will still be in the Beta Phase throughout the whole season. Further improvements/changes may occur in the future. Hopefully by March, a decision will be made as to how it will be handled.

Blog/Email Publishing Guidelines

The purpose of the Gold Canyon Pickleball Club website is to manage and promote the club within the resort.

Blogs and email campaigns are tightly focused on promoting activities, events and sessions offered by the club for the specific benefit to all club members. Blogs and emails must be relevant to Gold Canyon Pickleball activities only.

Blogs and email campaigns may not be used to:

- Advertise a commercial service or product whether available on-site or not
- Promote a non-club activity or event
- Deliver messages of a personal nature
- Deliver messages of a political nature
- Deliver messages not Pickleball related.

Exceptions:

A club member may apply for an exemption to the publishing guidelines (Webmaster – Lori Irvine). A request for exemption must be emailed to the Webmaster who will forward the request to the Board of Directors for a decision. The exemption will only be granted if a majority of the Board members determines that there is a high probability it will be of interest to a majority of the members.
